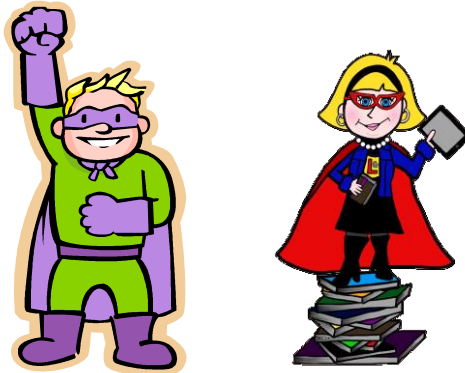

BLUE: Jacket Potatoes with beans and sausages

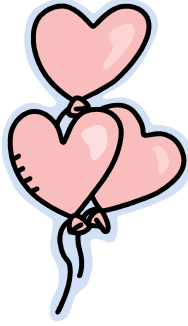
Dessert will be pancakes and ice cream
