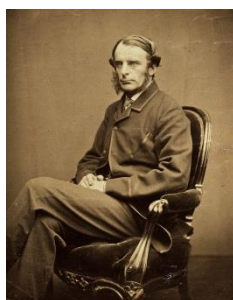

RACE FOR LIFE

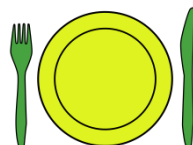

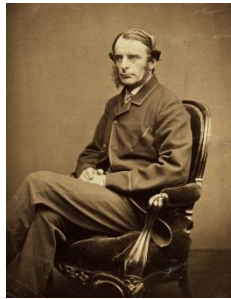

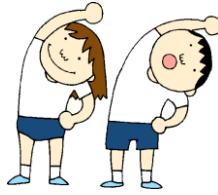
