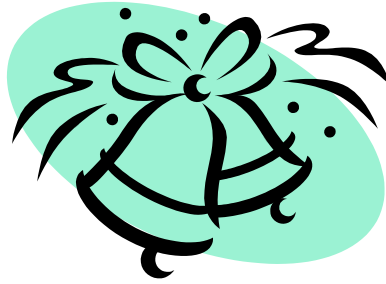

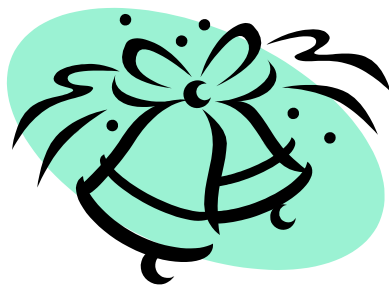
POEM OF MARRIAGE

PUPIL DATA COLLECTION FORMS

Your child should by now have given you a "Pupil Data Collection Form" which we need you to complete and return to the School Office, as part of our annual records review process. It is really important that under the new GDPR rules that every person that you detail on the form as an emergency contact, signs to give their permission for us to hold their data on our secure system.

At the end of the form there is another consent section that must be signed by both yourself and your partner, if you both wish to receive school communications i.e. Newsletters, notes about clubs etc. via our SCOPAY communication system. Obviously in a family if both Mum and Dad want to receive school communciations, you will both need to provide email addresses and mobile numbers as well as signing the end of the form to give you consent.

It is really important that as and when you have a change to any contact number or email address that you let the School Office know so that we can ensure that we have the most up to date contact details for your child
