Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to a new school year. It was lovely to see so many enthusiastic faces on the playground; they were from both parents and pupils! I hope you all had a lovely break and time with family and friends.

The start of term has been incredibly positive with the children settling quickly into routines and showing they are ready to learn.

As with all changes you will get mixed view pints but generally the feedback on the Fencing Site Security project has been very positive. The children are completely safe at playtimes and it has allowed staff to observe play and interactions rather than man gates!

The staff INSET day on Monday focussed on the School Values and Vision. It was a really positive day with staff sharing why they came into teaching and making us all take time out of the pressured day and Government agenda to reflect on our core purpose. The core values of the school is RESPECT. You will receive further information on the new Valued Model. The children have been working on this as part of their class work this week. We also spent time reviewing the School Behaviour Policy to ensure greater consistency across the school. This is because of the feedback received in the parent questionnaire and something that the Senior Leaders and Governors wanted to work on. This is still very much work in progress with the aim of reissuing the policy by half term.

We have welcomed 32 new pupils and families to Year R. They have been in school at some point this week and start properly on Monday. We also welcome new pupils and family to other year groups in the school. I know you will make them feel welcomed and looked after.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the School Uniform Policy. The children generally are looking very smart but a couple of pleas!

Pupils from both classes will need to be dropped off at Eversley Cricket Centre between 8:30 and 8:50 on Thursday mornings starting next week (13th September).
